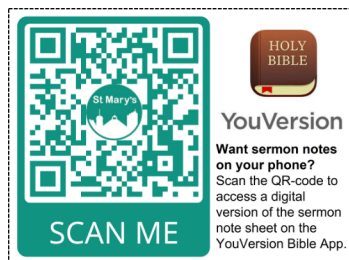


Galatians 3:15-29, 'Authentic Christianity: the authentic Bible'

1. There's no two ways to bless: promise ≠ law.
2. God's blessing is only ever through promise (vv.15–18).
3. God's blessing is never through law (vv.19–24).
4. God's blessing is received not achieved (vv.25–29).

1. How does God bless? Why is this important for the Galatians to grasp?
2. How is the law different to the promise?
3. Why is promise better than law?
4. Where might we be tempted to forget that God blesses by promise?
5. How can we be confident God blesses through promise, not law?
